Former Dress Shop Owner and Popular Omahan Passed on July 18

Former Omaha dress shop owner Eva Mac Dotson Davis passed on July 18 after a protracted illness which hospitalized her for several weeks. Mrs. Bavis was quite well known in the city and long regarded as one of the Northside's beauties. She and her beloved sister, Asilee Dotson Garland, were quite inseparable and seen together constantly.

Mrs. Davis operated Eva's Dress Shop near 24th and Lake Streets for fifteen years. She was well liked by everyone, probably because she was what can be referred to as "a rice person".

Eva Mac Dotson Davis was born August 23, 1911 in Smith County, Texas to John and Belzors Simpson Dotson. She departed this life July 18, 1990 in Omaha, Nebraska.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband, Goldle Davis.

Eva joined Zion Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. S.H. Botts.

She graduated from Howard Kennedy Elementary School and Technical High School. She was associated with many civic, social and cultural organizations.

For over forty years, she was a member of Schaffer Chapter #1, O.E.S. (PHA) Nebraska Jurisdiction.

She leaves to chorish her memory her sister, Asilee Detson Garland, of Omaha; her cousins and friends.
