Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday at Dundee Presbyterian Church for a retired kindergarten teacher who earned her bachelor's degree at the age of 66.

Mrs. E. H. Jones, 80, of 701 South Twenty-second Street died early Sunday at a local hospital.

In 1956, after 13 years of night and summer classes, Mrs. Jones received a degree in education from the University of Omaha. At that time she was a Kin dergarten teacher at Howard Kennedy School. She taught continuously at Howard Kennedy from 1937 until her retirement in 1960. Prior to her 1915 marriage, she taught for five years in Iowa elementary schools.
