

MAKE REPAIRS OF TEMPORARY NATURE AT OMAHA VIEW

Superintendent of Buildings Finlayson of the public schools, visited Omaha View school Friday again in company with W. B. Christie, chairman of the buildings and property committee and a patron of the school who has four children there.
