

THREATENS TO CLOSE OMAHA VIEW SCHOOL

**Unless Repairs Are Made by Monday
Withnell Says the Schools
Cannot Open.**

"Unless the board of education puts in the north steps and puts a steel ceiling on the boiler room of Omaha View school by next Monday I shall order the school closed that day," says Building Inspector Withnell.

Up to Wednesday morning the board had not done a thing toward making these required changes for the safety of the building.

When told what Mr. Withnell's ultimatum was Superintendent Finlayson of the school buildings said he had not so understood it, and further, that he doubted Mr. Withnell's authority.

The committee on buildings had not authorized making any such repairs.

Fire Chief Salter also told Mr. Finlayson that the sagging ceiling was not a good proposition and should be torn down or braced up.

Mr. Finlayson said, when he found out the situation, that he would get authority and make the changes and repairs demanded.
