

# OMAHA VIEW PLANS ACCEPTED BY BOARD

**Proviso Reads That Building Must  
Be Constructed for Amount Board  
Has Available.**

The plans prepared by Fisher & Law-  
rie for the new Omaha View school were  
last night accepted provisionally by the  
board of education. The provision is that  
the building can be constructed within  
the amount that the board considers  
available for the purpose.

The plans contemplate an absolutely  
fireproof building of sixteen rooms, and  
the architects declined to make an es-  
timate of the probable cost.

The resignations of Clara A. Ulrich,  
Minnie T. Baker and Pearl H. Conkley  
from the teaching force were accepted.

Anna M. Boutello was granted leave  
of absence until January 1, as she wishes  
to pursue studies at the Chicago art  
institute.

Eva Bartlett was granted a year's leave  
of absence.

County Superintendent Yoder was given  
use of the high school for the county  
teachers' annual institute during the  
week of August 24.

The Typographical union sent in a  
protest against the acceptance of the  
proposition of the Postner Printing com-  
pany to issue a handbook of the graded  
schools.

A proposition to purchase additional  
ground at the Franklin site for \$6,000 was  
turned down.

Brick sidewalks and roadways will be  
constructed at the new Vinton school at  
a cost of \$1,700.

The high school lunch privilege was  
again awarded to the Women's Christian  
Temperance union.

On motion of Member McCague, the  
board of education will ask representa-  
tion on the charter revision committee,  
to see that the interests of the school  
district are protected. Two years ago,  
the now charter was on the eve of pas-  
sage when it was found that it legisla-  
ted the board of education off the earth.  
The board representatives will be Presi-  
dent Cole, Member McCague and Attor-  
ney Hurd. They will only participate as  
to matters affecting the school board.
