

SCHOOL AFFAIRS

During the past year the Omaha View school, a sixteen-room building, has been nearly completed. It will be ready for use at the beginning of the second half of the school year in February. The Perost school, a sixteen-room building, has been started and will be finished in 1910. Each will cost \$100,000. The south wing of the High school has been under construction all of the year and will be finished by the spring vacation. Its cost will be \$150,000. A four-room annex has been built to the Beals school.

A site for the proposed new Miller Park school has been bought.

Manual training plants have been installed in the Franklin, Lothrop, Farnham, Beals and Clifton Hill schools.
