

NEW OMAHA VIEW SCHOOL WILL OPEN MONDAY

Handsome Sixteen-Room Structure Will Replace Shaky Old Building of Ten Rooms.

No more will parents tremble in fear for the safety of their children, and no longer will the children be scurried home every time a gentle zephyr chases a cloud across the sky, for the old Omaha View school at Thirty-second and Corby streets has been abandoned.

The new Omaha View school, a magnificent sixteen-room structure at Thirtieth and Binney streets, has been completed and will be occupied for the first time Monday morning.

At the old school, a ten-room structure, there were great cracks in the walls and ceilings, and the building tottered during every high wind. A year ago last fall, because of the failure to make some safeguards that were possible, the board of education was severely criticised, and the condition of the building was the scandal of the fall campaign.

Temporary repairs and provision to make egress easier in the event of fire were at once made to the old building, and the board got busy with the construction of the new one. Though there is some work yet to be done on the new building, the haste of the board to abandon the old building has caused it to order the occupancy of the new building a few days earlier than otherwise would have been done.

At the beginning but ten rooms will be occupied, but as soon as the overflow from the district that has been going to the Lothrop and Saratoga schools can be gotten back, more rooms will be opened. Miss Franc Eaton is the principal.

Though no definite decision has been reached with reference to the old building, several of the board members feel like acceding to the request of Superintendent of Buildings Finlayson, which is that it be torn down and the material used in building a supply depot for the board.
