Nursery School Starts Tomorrow

The first nursery school of its kind in Omaha will open tomorrow at Howard Kennedy school, it was reported last week by Miss Ingebord Nielsen, assistant state supervisor of the WPA child protection program.

Differing from other Omaha nursery schools in that it is an "educational" rather than a "play" school and that it will operate on a 10-hour-a-day, six-day-a-week schedule, the school will employ eight teachers and will care for children from 2 to 4 years old.

The Urban League is sponsoring the nursery, together with the board of education.
