



School Squeeze Being Eased

Two of the public schools' most serious overcrowding problems will be solved with the completion of additions to Howard Kennedy School, 2906 North Thirtieth Street, and Belvedere School, 6224 North Thirty-seventh Street. Two

pupils are pictured looking over the construction site of the Howard Kennedy addition, which will join the present building on the south. The addition will contain eight classrooms and a multi-purpose room. The second picture

shows work in progress on the Belvedere addition, which will include six classrooms, a multi-purpose room and office space. Contracts for the two jobs total \$849,823.
