

\$443,181 Cost of School Job

Contracts for Kennedy Addition Approved

The Omaha Board of Education Monday night approved \$443,181 in contract for an addition to Howard Kennedy School, 2906 North Thirtieth Street.

A general contract of \$374,409 was given to Foster-Smetana Company.

B. Grunwald Incorporated was awarded the mechanical contract of \$48,386.

An electric contract of \$20,380 went to David A. Baxter & Son.

The addition will include eight new classrooms and a multi-purpose room.

Officials said the additional classrooms were needed to meet overcrowded conditions at the school. Completion date is September 20.
