

The large map to the left shows the geographic location of elementary and junior high schools in the Omaha Public School District. Behind the name of each elementary school is the number of the cluster of which that school is a part. In the case of paired schools the name of the school it is paired with appears in brackets. If the school is exempt, that is indicated with the abbreviation Ex. Elementary schools are indicated with a circle and junior high schools with a square. You should be able to determine the exact location of all Omaha Public Schools, elementary and junior highs.
