Booker Rites on Thursday

Had Taught in Public, Parochial Schools

Funeral services for Miss Gertrude G. Booker, 62, a teacher in both public and parochial schools, will be held Thursday at 9 a. m. at Sacred Heart Church.

She died at her home at 2916 North Twenty-fourth Street last Thursday. Miss Booker, and her twin sister, the late Miss Lucy Booker, taught at Howard Kennedy School more than 10 years. Before that they taught in Kansas City, Mo., schools over a 20-year period. More recently Miss Gertrude Booker had taught at St. Benedict's School and was teaching at Sacred Heart School at the time of her death. She is survived by brothers Ellis R. of Waco, Tex., and Horace J., of Compton, Cal. Arosary will be recited Wednesday at 8 p. m. in the Thomas Funeral Home Chapel. Burial will be in Forest Lawn Cemetery.
