

Miss Effie Reed, 91, Retired Teacher, Dies

Miss Effie Reed, 91, retired Omaha teacher and school principal, died August 23 at Los Angeles, Cal., according to word received here by friends Thursday.

Miss Reed came to Omaha in 1885 from Winterset, Ia., where she had been principal of a school. She taught at Cass School, then became principal at Central Park School. She was the first principal of Franklin School.

Later she took over the principalship of Omaha View School and at the time of her retirement in 1920 was principal of Kellom School. She moved to the West Coast shortly after her retirement.
