Funeral services for Cecilie Forman of Omaha, a public - school teacher for more than 50 years, will be at 11:30 a.m. Tuesday at Holy Cross Church.

Mrs. Forman, 1624 S. 60th St., died of a heart ailment Saturday at her son's home in Murray, Neb., relatives said. She was 85.

After graduating from Kearney State Teachers College in 1922, Mrs. Forman taught at Kearney public schools for two years. From 1925 to 1931, she taught at Ashland Park School in Omaha.

She earned a degree in social work from the University of Omaha and was a social worker in Douglas County from 1939 to 1949.

About 1950, Mrs. Forman returned to teaching, this time at **Howard Kennedy** School. About 1960, she switched to the Windsor School, and retired in 1968. Mrs. Forman then served as a substitute teacher for the Omaha Public Schools until the early 1970s.

Survivors include husband John Sr., sons John Jr. of Omaha and Karel of Murray; brother John Prazan of Council Bluffs; sisters Anna Novotny of Omaha and Mildred Gogela of Lincoln; and five grandchildren.
