Funeral services for Lois R. Goode, 79, a longtime teacher and former member of the Omaha Public Library board, will be at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. John A.M.E. Church, 2402 N. 22nd St.

Mrs. Goode, who taught at **Howard Kennedy** School for 24 years before retiring in 1969, died at home Tuesday. The cause of death was not immediately known.

A native of Mattoon, Ill., she served on the library board from 1969 to 1981, and also served on the board of the YWCA and Morning Musicale.

She is survived by her husband, Alton, of Omaha; a brother, William Grey, of Chicago; and sisters, Bernice Grey, of Mattoon, Ill., and Norma Burney, of Chicago.
